ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF ALLEGHENY COUNTY AND CARLOW UNIVERSITY

Community College of Allegheny County and Carlow University recognize the importance of facilitating the transfer of students from one institution to another. In an effort to insure that transfer students and indigenous students be treated on an equal basis, The Community College of Allegheny County and Carlow University enter into the following articulation agreement. This agreement has been developed according to the guidelines established by the State System of Higher Education in Pennsylvania.

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT:

1. Academic Policies:

A student enrolled in a University Parallel Program at The Community College of Allegheny County, who completes all requirements for the designated Associate in Arts or Associate in Science degree may transfer to Carlow University and may expect the following:

- 1. To have the program of study at the Community College of Allegheny County reviewed and approved by the **Provost** at Carlow University.
- 2. To have all of the courses that are approved in the program of study and which carry a passing grade accepted by Carlow University.
- 3. To enjoy the same rights and privileges and observe the same regulations in the major department as students indigenous in that department who are at junior level when the transfer occurs.
- 4. To follow Carlow University policy, which requires that the student repeat any major/support courses that carry a final grade of "C-" or lower. The final grade for these courses must be a "C" or higher. Students will not earn additional credits for a repeated course.
- 5. To have all of the courses with a passing grade accepted by Carlow University applied to the attainment of a Baccalaureate degree.

2. Academic Stipulations:

1. A student who wants to participate in the articulation process must contact the Transfer Counselor at the Community College of Allegheny County.

- 2. The student, the academic advisor, and the transfer counselor will develop a program of study following guidelines provided by Carlow University and in accordance with the curriculum established by the Community College of Allegheny County.
- 3. The student will review the articulation agreement and will sign a letter of intent to transfer from the Community College of Allegheny County to Carlow University.
- 4. The transfer counselor will send the student's program of study within thirty days after the beginning of the fall and/or spring semester to the Registrar at Carlow University.
- 5. The designated representative at Carlow University will review, certify and return the program of study to the transfer counselor within thirty days after receipt of the program.
- 6. A student may initiate changes in his/her program of study by contacting the transfer counselor at the Community College of Allegheny County who will notify the designated representative at Carlow University regarding approval of changes.
- 7. A student must maintain an overall average of 2.0 GPA on a four-point scale. (The nursing and education majors are an exception and require an overall average of 3.0 GPA)
- 8. The Community College of Allegheny County will monitor the progress of students annually, reporting to the designated representatives at Carlow University those students who maintain eligibility.
- 9. A maximum of 65 credits will transfer into the University from the approved program. Any additional transfer credits will be subject to a course by course evaluation and must have a letter grade (s) of "C" or above.
- 10. No additional 100 and 200 level courses will be transferred into Carlow University from any institution without further evaluation (See nursing as an example).
- 11. Students must satisfy all other Carlow University admission requirements.
- 12. The attached program guide details the course equivalencies from the specified Community College of Allegheny County Programs and the specified Carlow University Programs.

3. Review of Agreement:

- 1. Community College of Allegheny County and Carlow University will review this articulation agreement annually by June 30th and make adjustments or amendments when necessary.
- 2. This agreement may be terminated by either party providing that at least six months advance notice of termination has been given.

EXCEPTIONS TO ARTICULATION AGREEMENT, PART I, NUMBER 5

PART I, Number5, states that a student enrolled in a University Parallel program at CCAC who completes all requirements for the associate degree may transfer to Carlow and may expect "To have all of the courses that are accepted by Carlow University applied to the attainment of the baccalaureate degree, thus resulting in the student's receiving full Junior status."

Exceptions to this statement are as follows:

Art Education

Students interested in transferring with junior status to Art Education at Carlow are advised to follow a course of study at CCAC, which reflects a higher concentration of art courses than that provided through the parallel programs. A copy of this recommended course of study is available in the Community College of Allegheny County transfer counselor's office.

Nursing

Because of the sequence of the Carlow nursing program and the requisite preparatory support courses, it is not possible for students who follow the parallel programs to transfer into Carlow's nursing program at junior level.

Students interested in nursing at Carlow may complete an AS in nursing at Community College of Allegheny County and apply for admission to Carlow's BSN program and advanced standing as registered nurses. Nursing credits do not transfer, but students are granted a 30 credit technical block. This block plus the non-nursing credits from the AS program should place the student at junior level.

Students interested in Carlow's nursing program who are not enrolled in the AS in nursing program at Community College of Allegheny County are advised to plan to apply for admission to the nursing program at Carlow at the end of their freshman year. An approved plan of study for the freshman year at Community College of Allegheny County is available.

Perfusion Technology Certification

Student who follow the parallel program and are interested in obtaining a BS in Biology with Certification in Perfusion Technology should expect to spend an additional three years at Carlow.

It may be possible to complete the program in two additional years at Carlow if the student follows a program of study at Community College of Allegheny County, which reflects a higher concentration of science courses than that provided through the parallel programs. A recommended course of study is available in the Community College of Allegheny County transfer counselor's office.

Attached to this Agreement are Curriculum Guides for additional programs offered by COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF ALLEGHENY COUNTY that also transfer to Carlow University. Guides on the following pages can be used by transfer counselors to assist students interested in these areas.
